



TDG Program/Project Management (PPM) Executive Course

This is a tailored course specifically designed for each session offering based on the current activities and projects of the participants. Typically, participants submit program material including desired topics two to three weeks in advance of the class and complete a PPM Knowledge Assessment online.

The learning objective of the course is to provide executive level education and coaching in an educational environment (away from the office) that will provide the participants with direct feedback and takeaways that they can immediately put to use.

Course material covers the PMI PMBOK® Guide five PM processes and nine knowledge areas. This course is typically offered in a 3-day format and is targeted for senior and executive level portfolio, program, or project managers and other executives. The PPM executive course is worth 24 PMI Professional Development Units (PDUs). The PMI R.E.P. program number for this course is PM30EXEC.
